## The Lesson from the Second Book of Great and Glorious Prophet Moses, Barekhamor!

### Exodus 30:34-38 New King James Version (NKJV)

#### The Incense

<sup>34</sup> And the LORD said to Moses: "Take sweet spices, stacte and onycha and galbanum, and pure frankincense with *these* sweet spices; there shall be equal amounts of each. <sup>35</sup> You shall make of these an incense, a compound according to the art of the perfumer, salted, pure, *and* holy. <sup>36</sup> And you shall beat *some* of it very fine, and put some of it before the Testimony in the tabernacle of meeting where I will meet with you. It shall be most holy to you. <sup>37</sup> But *as for* the incense which you shall make, you shall not make any for yourselves, according to its <sup>[a]</sup>composition. It shall be to you holy for the LORD.

<sup>38</sup> Whoever makes *any* like it, to smell it, he shall be cut off from his people."

# The Lesson from the Psalms of David, the King and Prophet, Barekhamor!

## Psalm 20 New King James Version (NKJV)

### The Assurance of God's Saving Work

*To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David.*

20 May the LORD answer you in the day of trouble;  
May the name of the God of Jacob <sup>[a]</sup>defend you;

<sup>2</sup> May He send you help from the sanctuary,  
And strengthen you out of Zion;

<sup>3</sup> May He remember all your offerings,  
And accept your burnt sacrifice. *Selah*

<sup>4</sup> May He grant you according to your heart's *desire*,  
And fulfill all your <sup>[b]</sup>purpose.

<sup>5</sup> We will rejoice in your salvation,  
And in the name of our God we will set up *our* banners!  
May the LORD fulfill all your petitions.

<sup>6</sup> Now I know that the LORD saves His <sup>[c]</sup>anointed;  
He will answer him from His holy heaven  
With the saving strength of His right hand.

<sup>7</sup> Some *trust* in chariots, and some in horses;  
But we will remember the name of the LORD our God.

<sup>8</sup> They have bowed down and fallen;  
But we have risen and stand upright.

<sup>9</sup> Save, LORD!  
May the King answer us when we call.

## The Lesson from the book of Isaiah, the Glorious Prophet, Barekhmor!

### Isaiah 14:22-27 New King James Version (NKJV)

#### Babylon Destroyed

<sup>22</sup> “For I will rise up against them,” says the LORD of hosts,  
“And cut off from Babylon the name and remnant,  
And offspring and posterity,” says the LORD.  
<sup>23</sup> “I will also make it a possession for the porcupine,  
And marshes of muddy water;  
I will sweep it with the broom of destruction,” says the LORD of hosts.

#### Assyria Destroyed

<sup>24</sup> The LORD of hosts has sworn, saying,  
“Surely, as I have thought, so it shall come to pass,  
And as I have purposed, so it shall stand:  
<sup>25</sup> That I will break the Assyrian in My land,  
And on My mountains tread him underfoot.  
Then his yoke shall be removed from them,  
And his burden removed from their shoulders.  
<sup>26</sup> This *is* the purpose that is purposed against the whole earth,  
And this *is* the hand that is stretched out over all the nations.  
<sup>27</sup> For the LORD of hosts has purposed,  
And who will annul *it*?  
His hand *is* stretched out,  
And who will turn it back?”

## The Lesson from the General Epistle of the Acts of the Apostle, Barekhamor!

### Acts 1:15-20 New King James Version (NKJV)

#### **HABIBAI,**

<sup>15</sup> And in those days Peter stood up in the midst of the <sup>[a]</sup>disciples (altogether the number of names was about a hundred and twenty), and said, <sup>16</sup> “Men *and* brethren, this Scripture had to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit spoke before by the mouth of David concerning Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus; <sup>17</sup> for he was numbered with us and obtained a part in this ministry.”

<sup>18</sup> (Now this man purchased a field with the <sup>[b]</sup>wages of iniquity; and falling headlong, he burst open in the middle and all his <sup>[c]</sup>entrails gushed out. <sup>19</sup> And it became known to all those dwelling in Jerusalem; so that field is called in their own language, Akel Dama, that is, Field of Blood.)

<sup>20</sup> “For it is written in the Book of Psalms:

‘Let his dwelling place be <sup>[d]</sup>desolate,  
And let no one live in it’;

and,

‘Let another take his <sup>[e]</sup>office.’

## **The Lesson from the First Epistle of St. Paul the Apostle to the Corinthians, Barekhmor!**

### 1 Corinthians 8:1-6 New King James Version (NKJV)

**Be Sensitive to Conscience**

**AHAI,**

8 Now concerning things offered to idols: We know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge <sup>[a]</sup>puffs up, but love <sup>[b]</sup>edifies. <sup>2</sup> And if anyone thinks that he knows anything, he knows nothing yet as he ought to know. <sup>3</sup> But if anyone loves God, this one is known by Him.

<sup>4</sup> Therefore concerning the eating of things offered to idols, we know that an idol *is* nothing in the world, and that *there is* no other God but one. <sup>5</sup> For even if there are so-called gods, whether in heaven or on earth (as there are many gods and many lords), <sup>6</sup> yet for us *there is* one God, the Father, of whom *are* all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, through whom *are* all things, and through whom we *live*.

## Gospel Reading:

### Matthew 15:32-39 New King James Version (NKJV)

#### Feeding the Four Thousand

<sup>32</sup> Now Jesus called His disciples to *Himself* and said, “I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now continued with Me three days and have nothing to eat. And I do not want to send them away hungry, lest they faint on the way.”

<sup>33</sup> Then His disciples said to Him, “Where could we get enough bread in the wilderness to fill such a great multitude?”

<sup>34</sup> Jesus said to them, “How many loaves do you have?”

And they said, “Seven, and a few little fish.”

<sup>35</sup> So He commanded the multitude to sit down on the ground. <sup>36</sup> And He took the seven loaves and the fish and gave thanks, broke *them* and gave *them* to His disciples; and the disciples *gave* to the multitude.

<sup>37</sup> So they all ate and were filled, and they took up seven large baskets full of the fragments that were left. <sup>38</sup> Now those who ate were four thousand men, besides women and children. <sup>39</sup> And He sent away the multitude, got into the boat, and came to the region of <sup>[a]</sup>Magdala.
